Progress with Electric Vehicles and Charging Stations [faucet]

Last year San Diego reached a major milestone. Our city now has more than 13,000 electric vehicles (EVs) on the road and the state surpassed 100,000 in plug-in car sales, setting a world record. These accomplishments help to achieve Governor Brown's goals of putting 1.5 million zero emission vehicles on California roads by the year 2025.

Essential to meeting this goal is having enough plug-in EV chargers available. SDG&E® is proposing to install 5,500 charging stations at workplaces and multi-family communities over the next five years, as 50% of our region's residents are living in apartments and condos, but few locations offer EV charging.

In the future, special rates with the installation of grid integrated electric vehicle charging stations will allow EV customers to help lower their fuel costs by taking advantage of pricing during the time of day when capacity is plentiful and energy prices may be low.
